It helps especially to think of those who have passed away since last November 1. I invite you to pray the following prayer:

and of those who are in Purgatory on my account.*

*I recommend to Thee the souls of evangelical laborers,
of Religious and priests,
and especially of those who had charge of my soul.*

to the Blessed Virgin Mary,
the souls who are most abandoned,
those who suffer most,
and those who are nearest to the entrance into paradise.*

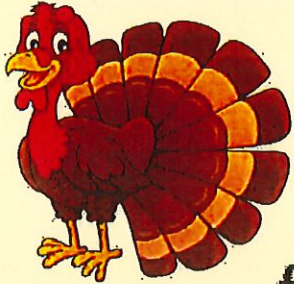
