Today we celebrate the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time. Next weekend is the Solemnity of Christ the King (Sunday), and the following weekend (Sunday) is the first Sunday in Advent, the beginning of the new liturgical year. As we anticipate the beginning of the new year, maybe we could begin now to form new year "resolutions." How are we going to intensify our love of God this year? Time to change times of prayer?
