Message from Father Stephen Hansen:

Today we celebrate the last Sunday in Ordinary Time. Next Sunday we'll conclude Ordinary time with Christ the King. As the month of November ends, I enter my last days as interim President of the St. Joseph Catholic Academy. I suppose some of my schedule will get a little more "ordinary."

I want to thank you for your patience with me in not being as "available" for parish things. 
