Father Hansen's message . . . A couple of weeks ago, I updated you on some generous gifts we were given at the Cathedral parish and school. Since then, I had lunch with some friends who informed me of a special tax benefit available this year for gifts to charities (like Cathedral parish and school/ECC, St. Mary's, and the Annual Catholic Appeal).

The CARES Act, signed into law in March 2020, made several important alterations to the tax code as it pertains to charitable contributions. Of note, the new laws raised the allowable deduction on cash donations to qualifying non-profit 501(c)(3) organizations (like a Catholic school or parish potentially) from 60% of AGI to 100% of AGI. Put simply, a cash donation of \$100 to your Church or another qualifying organization results in a dollar-for-dollar deduction of \$100 against your AGI for 2021. Incentives go beyond just cash contributions. Gifting of appreciated securities (for example, stocks in your portfolio that are sitting at a large gain position), rather than cash, can provide additional benefits. Donating a security with an unrealized capital gain allows you to not only take a 30% deduction against AGI based on the fair market value of the security, but also allows you to avoid paying capital gains tax on the appreciation of that security since you had owned it.

The sharing of time, talent, and treasure are essential for the gifts to keep multiplying on the hill tops of Cathedral and St. Mary's, and in the Diocese.

Christ is really present in our tabernacles and, during Adoration during the school day and he is really present when you pray with your families and with others. He is really present when the children are taught with the love of God, and even when we do our ordinary work well for the love of God!

Sharing our talent in teams with projects around the campuses builds community and gets work done with the talents shared with the participants. Watch for continuation of Operation Beautification and the Grounds Committee soon. Sharing treasures multiply in that they are spent with the love of God in mind, especially in the works of Mercy that are made possible... God is never outdone in multiplying... Please consider studying this CARES Act benefit to giving this year or consult your tax accountant!

As we approach Thanksgiving, I want to express my thanks to each of you for sharing your time with God, your talents, and for sharing your treasures with Cathedral of St. Joseph and St. Mary's and all their ministries! I want to also thank those who have given to the Annual Catholic Appeal already (I will get my donation set up this coming week)! Happy Thanksgiving!

- ◆ Monthly Pastor Coaching on various aspects of Parish life.

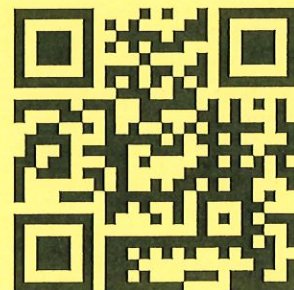
