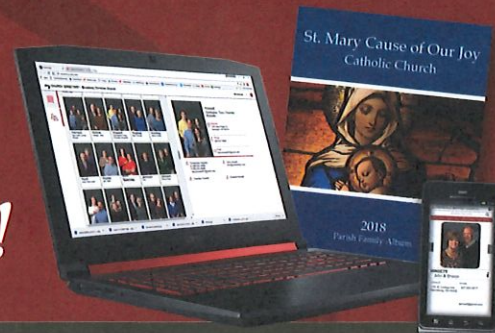
**School and St. Gianna’s ECC News**
