**Deacon Joshua Fultz’s message...** Model of a Christian Life

*When the Pharisees heard that he had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together, and one of them [a scholar of the law] tested him by asking, “Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?” He said to him, “You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the greatest and the first commandment. The second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.*

— *Matthew 22: 34-39.*

Have you ever sat and thought about what it means to live a Christian life? If I asked you to describe what it looks like I’m sure you’d say things like, “going to church on Sunday,” or maybe “a person who doesn’t swear,” or even “just being a nice person.” All of these are good answers, but they are not complete. I believe that living a Christian life means living the life modeled by Jesus, a life of quiet service.

I have had a little time to think about that this week with the passing of Deacon Steve Welsh. When Mandy & I first joined the church, Dcn. Steve and his wife Catherine were on the RCIA team that helped bring us home. I remember Mandy and I talking about how they were people “we’d like to be.” Something about them modeled a life that we wanted to live. Rarely did I see one without the other. I’m sure they had separate ministries, but it was good to see them working together in service to other people. They did so many things together including ministering to the individuals at Living Community. Dcn. Steve always seemed to just have a joyful peace about him, even during these last 11 years. Anytime I would ask how he was doing he would just say fine and then proceed to ask about me or Mandy and how he could pray for us. His world revolved around his faith, his family, and caring for everyone else in between.

His model of living like a Christian has helped to form my idea of how I would like to be remembered as a deacon. I want to be like Dcn. Steve, calm, gentle, and funny. I want to be eager to serve others like he did, and to share how much I love my faith like he did. Now before you remind me that he’s not canonized, I realize he wasn’t perfect, but then neither am I. We are all sinners. The key is realizing that we are and then trying to do what Christ told us to do, “You shall love your neighbor as yourself.” It’s in these moments when out of our love for God, we turn around and share that love with our neighbors. That is how we can be the model of a Christian life.
