Father Hansen's message . . .

If today were not a Sunday it would be the Memorial of St. Ignatius of Antioch. He, in about the year 115, used the word Catholic to describe the Church. He wrote, including the word Catholic, this:

See that you all follow the bishop, even as Jesus Christ does the Father, and the presbytery as you would the apostles; and reverence the deacons, as being the institution of God. Let no man do anything connected with the Church without the bishop. Let that be deemed a proper Eucharist, which is administered either by the bishop, or by one to whom he has entrusted it. Wherever the bishop shall appear, there let the multitude of the people also be; even as wherever Jesus Christ is, there is the Catholic Church.—Letter to the Smyrnaeans, Ch 8

This past Monday we celebrated the Memorial of Pope St. John XXII, who called the Second Vatican Council on that day (October 11) in 1962. When Pope St. John opened the Council, he said this:

The Church has never failed to oppose these errors, and has even condemned them often, indeed with the greatest severity. But at the present time the Spouse of Christ is pleased to apply the medicine of mercy, rather than take up the weapons of severity. She judges it prudent to meet the needs of today by demonstrating more amply the power of her teaching, rather than by condemning.

As we go through our ordinary lives and are thankful for the Eucharistic presence of God in our Tabernacles and in the handing down of the teachings on faith and morals, infallibly let us share these truths and gifts with Mercy! Let us be mindful that another Pope and Saint, John Paul II, said that "the greatest attribute of God is Mercy!"
