Dear Parishioners.

I write this on Tuesday, from Benedictine College where I spend one day month giving spiritual direction. It was a surprise to me when I received a call about being assigned as administrator of Our Lady of Guadalupe. However, as I shared last week with the parishioners there, I was happy to help. I am also thankful to the front office staff I met with on Monday. They're "all in," in this difficult time. The same can be said of the staffs at St. Mary's and Cathedral. Never hesitate to contact them, or me directly through the parish office or by emailing me at shansen@cathedralsi.org.

I'd like to share the quote of Pope Francis that I shared last weekend in my homily, and then invite you to something. First, the quote:

In order to bear fruit we must remain united to Jesus (cf. Jn 15:4-9). This union is achieved through daily prayer, particularly in Eucharistic adoration, as we remain in silence in the presence of the Lord, who remains with us in the Blessed Sacrament. By lovingly cultivating this communion with Christ, the <u>missionary</u> disciple can become a mystic in action. May our hearts always yearn for the company of Jesus, echoing the ardent plea of the two disciples of Emmaus, especially in the evening hours: "Stay with us, Lord!" (cf. Lk 24:29).

My invitation to you is to spend a little time in one of the periods of Eucharistic Adoration at the parish or the MIR House (24 Hours). Adoration is dedicated to the Academy schools whenever school is in session at the Cathedral. Remaining in silence in the presence of the Lord in the exposed Host is a unique way to cultivate the communion we have with Christ. St. Clair of Assisi even held off the approaching army of the Saracens by holding up the monstrance with the consecrated Host on the city wall! The Saracens turned around. Jesus, in times of Adoration, will hold off your spiritual enemies, and warm you with lights leading to your being a "mystic in action," in the words of Pope Francis. Another option would be to simply spend time before the Tabernacle if Adoration isn't possible.


