A Message from Father Stephen Hansen

I first learned about Sister Faustina, now Saint, when I was in medical school. I remember now, like it was yesterday, when the priest at St. Augustin's in Des Moines gave me as my penance, to say one of the nine prayers in the Novena of Divine Mercy, given to us by Jesus through Sister Faustina.

That Confession stands out to me personally as a turning point in how I see Confession, and back then was a turning point in my desire to be a priest. More on this another time... But, I invite you to ask Sr. Faustina to help you overcome obstacles to going to Confession, to help you make a confession if it's been years, and to help you make even better confessions if you go regularly. She will help!

One of the messages of Divine Mercy that St. Faustina helped us see, which we talk about every year on the Sunday after Easter Sunday (Divine Mercy Sunday), is works of Mercy. One of the works of Mercy is educating children. For 125 years Cathedral Parish has been doing this!
