#### Message from Father Benjamin Armentrout . . .

As we are wrapping up the month of October and about to enter the month of November, it is worth keeping in mind the devotions the Church earnestly commends us to practice in these two months. The month of October is customarily devoted to Our Lady of the Rosary. This feast is celebrated each year on October 7<sup>th</sup>, but the entire month is entrusted to our Lady who, because of her union with her son, plays a special role in our salvation. St. Louis Marie de Montfort in his classic work on the rosary liked to imagine each "Hail Mary" to be like a rose set before Mary! I personally find it quite helpful to have an image like that in my mind while praying the rosary so that I do not hastily fumble through my beads!

The month of November is a month that is especially devoted to praying for the Holy Souls in Purgatory! Each year, the Church commends us to set aside some time to visit cemeteries and pray for our beloved dead. I would encourage, in preparation for this month, that we each spend a little time in some of the scriptures: Revelation 12:27, Habacuc 1:13, Matthew 12:32 (which implies there are some sins forgiven in the next life), II Maccabees 12:39-46. Finally, I would also encourage revisiting several catechism paragraph numbers 1030-1032. Let us continue to entrust our hearts to Mary our Heavenly Mother and ask her to intercede for our beloved dead!
