In reference to the letter sent out by **Bishop Johnston** and spoken about at Mass by **Father Hansen**, there has been some confusion as to the identity of the **Bishop Sullivan** on the list of priests with substantiated allegation of abuse of minors. It is **NOT** the former **Bishop of Kanas City-St. Joseph, John Joseph Sullivan** who served here as bishop from 1977-1993. The priest names in the letter refers to deceased Baton Rouge **Bishop Joseph Vincent Sullivan** who served here as a priest from 1946-1967 and as auxiliary from 1967-1974, before being appointed Bishop of Baton Rouge in 1974. He died in 1982. The various rooms and ministries in our diocese named after **Bishop Sullivan** are named after our former **Bishop John Joseph Sullivan**, who is NOT the man on the list of accused.




