Thank you so much for your prayers. The overnight ferry between Vladivostok and Korea started running again in August, so I'm returning home by ferry, then a train to Seoul, and a flight the next day via Seattle to Kansas City. Please continue to pray for peace in Ukraine. All over the city here are billboards asking for volunteers to sign up to fight on behalf of Russia...

Happy Birthday to our Blessed Mother! To think that God chose Mary to be the mother of Jesus and filled her with grace already at her conception, so that she never had original sin (Dec. 8—Immaculate Conception)! What a miracle! And the day of her birth nine months later on September 8...angels must have been present, and it must have been the most joyful day of St. Anne and St. Joachim's life. They had waited many years for a child, and Mary must have been exceptionally beautiful because of her purity of heart. It's not too late to celebrate Mary's birthday today, if you missed it on Thursday. 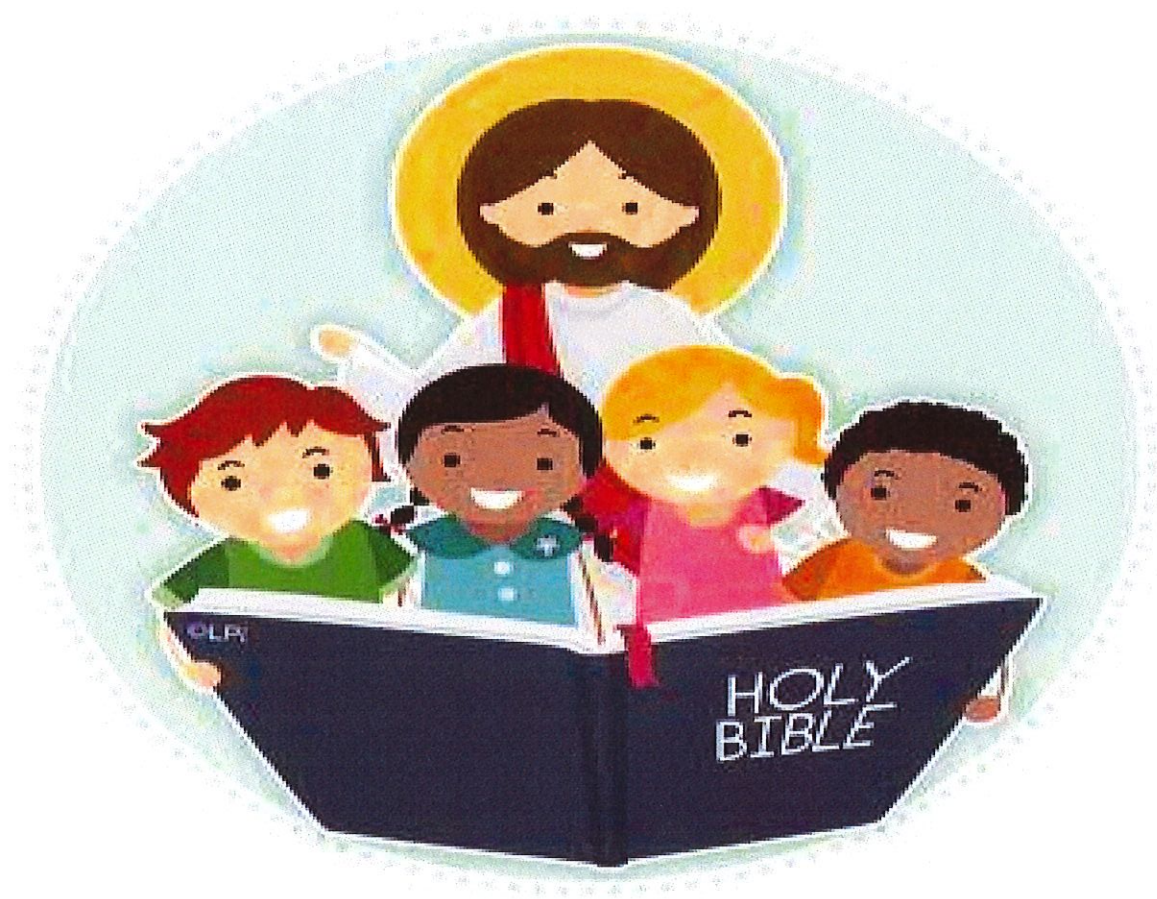

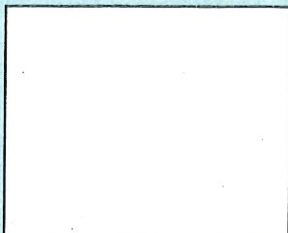

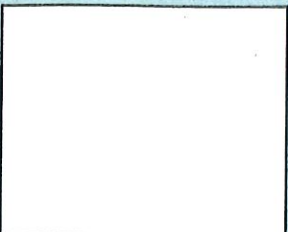
