Greetings from Vladivostok! You are in our daily prayers. Sr. Faustina visited Mother Julia on her way to Russia, and they had a good visit. We have been together here since August 14. All the flights went well. On August 19, a family came to stay with us for a few days. The parents said that they wanted their two children to be able to learn more about God!

I have been playing the organ for Mass, and Sr. Faustina and Sr. Joanna are singing in the parish choir. It has been wonderful to help lead the Catholic student group again, using some materials from the National Eucharistic Revival.

We celebrated Sr. Faustina's birthday on August 28 (feast of St. Augustine), and Sr. Joanna renewed her vows on that day. We invited the parish for a picnic on August 31, and then went to Irkutsk September 1-10 for the diocesan sisters' retreat held at Lake Baikal. We had not been in three years, and it was a rare opportunity to see our Russian bishop and other sisters from this Diocese of St. Joseph (Irkutsk, Russia). RCIA started at our parish in Vladivostok last Sunday, and there are at least four or five people so far who are interested in joining the Church at Easter! Children's Catechesis starts this Sunday, September 15. College starts for our students on Sept 18.

It is such a blessing knowing that you're praying for us! You are a vital part of this mission because your prayers help open doors and convert hearts.
