Message from Father Benjamin Armentrout . . .

This past week on the Feast of St. Matthew, which falls annually on September 21st, I had the privilege of offering a grandparent's Mass at Bishop LeBlond. It wasn't just the fact that our students were surrounded by their loving grandparents and special guests that made the occasion a cheerful one! It was also the anniversary of Bishop Charles Hubert LeBlond's episcopal consecration. I happily used his chalice, given to him by Creviston Jewelers, to consecrate the precious Blood in the school consecrated to his memory!

Bishop LeBlond was a noteworthy man and remarkable prelate. In looking up many old newspapers, one would note that this man of God possessed a servant's heart. He fought tirelessly for the life of the Church. One issue, among several for which Bishop LeBlond fought tirelessly, was the proper implementation of the Catholic Social teaching on the dignity of the human person and the dignity of human work as taught by the encyclicals *Rerum Novarum* (Pope Leo XIII) and *Quadragesimo Anno* (Pius XI). In fact, just prior to his appointment as the Bishop of St. Joseph, he traveled to Lima, Peru as an American Delegate at a Pan-American conference on child welfare. It is worth recalling that Social Justice without the Gospel is no justice at all! Bishop LeBlond served the poor and saw to the education because of the Gospel- not some distorted idea of social betterment.

Bishop LeBlond was the primary consecrator of a priest of this Diocese, Bishop Buddy. Bishop LeBlond retired from his Episcopal see during the year 1956, at which point our Diocese of St. Joseph was merged with the Diocese of Kansas City. But just prior to his retirement, he ordained my great-great uncle as a priest of the Diocese of St. Joseph who served as the parochial vicar of the Cathedral for two years. I am so grateful for the opportunity to be teaching and serving as the chaplain at a school named after such an important person in our local church's history, and important in even my own family's history! May our Lord continue to bless our diocese, our city, our parishes, our schools, and especially Bishop LeBlond High School so "that in all things God might be glorified!"
