Labor Day – Time, Talent, and Treasure

This Labor Day weekend I want to thank you for sharing the fruit of your labors (treasures) and your talents with the parishes and schools!! St. Joseph's Catholic presence, especially the Tabernacles that surround our city, could not be here without you helping us keep the lights on, buildings maintained, and if I can say this, the refrigerator with food in it for priests, Sisters, and seminarians...
