Father Armentrout's message . . . I asked some students at LeBlond what I should write my bulletin article on this month, and one of the students piped up without hesitation, "The Rosary." This month is devoted to the *Sorrows of Mary*, so I'd like to take a moment to share a few thoughts on the principal Sorrow of Mary to aid in your praying of the Rosary!

The Fifth of the Sorrowful mysteries is "*The Crucifixion of our Lord*." The primary text most Catholics think of regarding this sorrow of Mary is found in John 19 (Look it up!). All the other sorrows, and in fact *all* the events in her life, prepared her to assist her Son in his great act of redemption! John the Evangelist remarks who all was present at this salvific event - Mary, John, etc., And before our Lord passed away, remember his words - "Woman, behold your son." Although it might seem odd that our Lord called his mother, "Woman," I think we should be quick to recall that this was the exact word that was used to describe Eve in Genesis! Mary is the New Eve, the first Woman. Whereas Eve became the mother of us all in the order of natural life, Mary becomes the Mother of us all in the order of grace. Mary leads us to her Son who is ever ready to bestow His abundant graces upon us. St. Bernard reflected quite emotionally on this passage with these words - "Were those words: *Woman behold your Son*, not more than a sword to the division between soul and spirit? What an exchange! John is given to you in place of the Lord, the disciple in place of the master; the son of Zebedee replaces the Son of God, a mere man replaces God himself. How could these words not pierce your most loving heart when the mere remembrance of them breaks ours, hearts of stone and iron though they are!" As we wrap up this month on the *Sorrows of Mary* and prepare for the month of the Rosary, I highly encourage you to spend time praying this perennial Catholic Devotion. - Fr. Armentrout

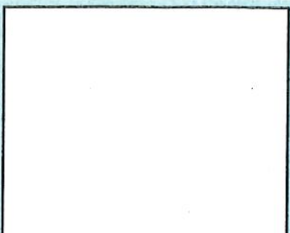

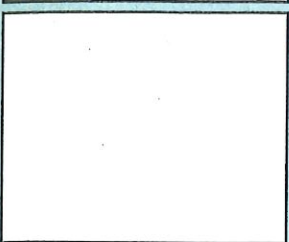
