A Word from Fr. Stephen Hansen

This 23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time, if it were not a Sunday, would be the celebration of the birthday of Mary. Of course, her Immaculate Conception was celebrated nine months ago, on December 8th.

This Sunday, at the St. Joseph Church in Easton, we'll receive into the church a young lady who was baptized earlier in life. However, after formation and example of family and friends, she wants to join the Catholic Church. I asked her last Sunday what led to this decision to make a Profession of Faith, get Confirmed, and receive her First Communion (after making her first Confession). She answered, "I came to believe the Eucharist as really Jesus; why wouldn't I want to enter the Church?"

As we continue our journey in Ordinary Time, let's turn to Our Lady in a special way on her birthday (the young lady has chosen Mary as her Confirmation name). Let's ask her to help us - as we pray at least part of the Rosary daily - with our spiritual reading of the Bible and a good book (maybe from Blessings of St. Joseph). Let's ask her to help us meditate on highlights of what we've read or encountered in daily life. Finally, let's ask her to help us give ourselves more completely in service of others, pleasing Jesus – who we encounter along the way – and discovering ourselves, too.

I will add that, in two weeks, we'll begin the inquiry period for those who are considering entering the Catholic Church. Arman Partamian, our RCIA Coordinator, will meet, assisted by others, most Sunday afternoons. If this time is not good due to work, please do not hesitate to reach out to him or me nonetheless; we'll work out some classes for all!
